

# MODERN SLAVERY STATEMENT FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED 31<sup>st</sup> May 2025

WCF Ltd recognises that modern slavery and human trafficking are significant global issues presenting a challenge for businesses worldwide. We are committed to improving and refining our practices to combat slavery and human trafficking.

## Organisational Structure

We have several trading divisions, which are shown below:

All our operations are based in the UK and we employ around 372 colleagues.

## Supply Chains

With regards to national or international supply chains, our preferred point of contact is with a UK Company and we expect these entities to have suitable anti-slavery and human trafficking policies and processes.

We expect all our suppliers and customers to obey national and international standards that require them to treat workers and employees fairly and to provide a safe working environment. We have reviewed our major suppliers published statements in respect of the Modern Slavery Act to ensure that their operations (both in the UK and overseas) have suitable preventative measures in place to prevent modern slavery. We are committed to having an ongoing and open dialogue with our suppliers and will continue to review statements over time.

## Training

To ensure each trading division has a level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business, all divisional Business Managers have been issued a guide to the Modern Slavery Act and are fully aware of the supporting policies mentioned above.
